LOGO

- The logo for the Latvian presidency of the Council of the European Union is based on the classic image of the grinding stone. The circular stone has been known throughout Europe for centuries and is rich in associations.
- The grinding stone was once a significant innovation and a trigger of change in households across Europe. Today, it remains the instrument that brings about bread, the symbol of nourishment and prosperity. Made from stone, it can endure centuries of motion and still sustain productivity.
- The circular shape of the grinding stone suggests unity and wholeness the commonly held ideals and values upon which the European project is built.
- The dynamic movement of the rotating grinding stone brings about energy and growth with which Europe meets new challenges. With Latvia at the wheel, Europeans are certain to gain new perspectives.
